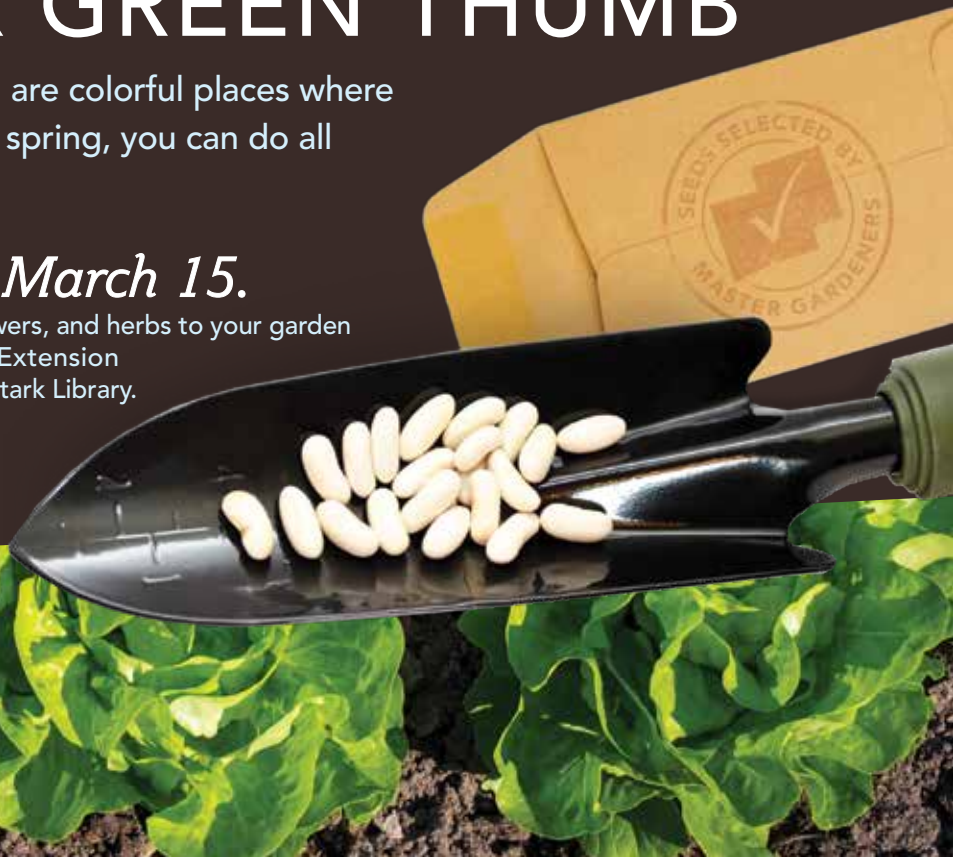
Lettuce Celebrate YOUR GREEN THUMB

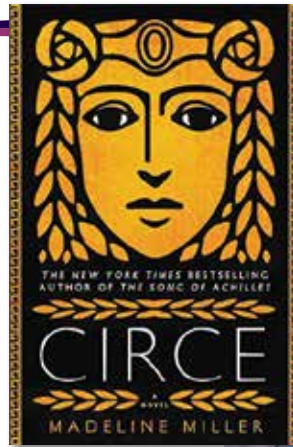

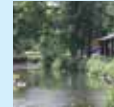
