Library to host New York Times bestselling mystery author Linda Castillo

June 28, 2016 (Canton, Ohio) – Stark County District Library is hosting two book discussions with author Linda Castillo. Castillo is a New York Times Best Selling author who has written numerous novels generally focused on the Amish Thriller genre. Castillo be at the Lake Community Branch on July 13th from 2-3pm and at the Perry Sippo Branch on July 13th from 6:30-7:30pm.

The focus of Castillo's presentations will be her newest release, "Among the Wicked," an Amish mystery thriller set in Holmes County, Ohio. The book will also be available for purchase and autograph signature. Castillo wrote her first novel at age thirteen and has since published 30 books for three New York publishing houses.

Both of the presentations are made possible through the support of the Friends of the Library (FOL). FOL groups raise funds to support local libraries in a variety of ways. The Lake Community and Perry Sippo FOLs are sponsoring Linda Castillo's visit.

Castillo is originally from Ohio, where her Amish thrillers are set. Her work has gained popularity and praise through the years, granting her several awards and nominations. Her debut thriller, "Sworn to Silence," spent four weeks on the New York Times bestseller list and eventually was adapted into a two-hour movie re-titled "An Amish Murder."

Based on her popularity the library anticipates these presentations to be very well received by the community. Marianna DiGiacomo, Director of Community Services, is pleased to offer Castillo as a speaker. "We are excited to once again host Linda Castillo at two of our libraries. She is a very popular author and always draws a big crowd when she visits Stark County District Library," said DiGiacomo.
