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Library to host free health, wellness and fitness events

March 29, 2016 (Canton, Ohio) – Stark County District Library is hosting three free health events which will address general health, fitness, diet, and e-health devices.

On Wednesday, March 30 from 2:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. the Perry Sippo Library will host, “New Year, New You, Tracking your Health through Technology.” The program will teach attendees about the innovative technological apps and devices that help people stay on track with their health and wellness. Attendees will have the opportunity to test some of the devices and learn about programming from Stark Parks that will help them achieve their health goals and utilize some of the new technology.

On Wednesday, March 30 from 10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. the Lake Community Library will host, “Spring Health and Fitness Fair.” The health fair will include representatives from the Alzheimer’s Association, Arukah Market, Lake YMCA, Mercy Medical, NEO Today and SOL Pizza Pie. Attendees will have the chance to speak with representatives from each organization and they will receive free samples and screenings.

On Thursday, April 14 from 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. the Main Library will collaborate with Mercy Medical Center to host the annual Community Health Fair. The Community Health Fair will include free blood pressure screenings, vouchers for free blood screenings, and free advanced directives. Representatives from the Crisis Center, Head Start, Prescription Assistance Network and more will be available to speak with attendees and offer assistance.

All three events are free and open to the public. Collaborative events such as health and wellness programs are representative of the Library’s strategic initiative to Share Smart by collaborating with other organizations in the community.
