### Stark County District Library Perry Sippo Branch hosting Scared Scriptless comedy performance group

**August 20, 2015 (Canton, OH)** –Stark County District Library Perry Sippo Branch is hosting Scared Scriptless, a local comedy improv group. The performance will be held on Friday, August 21, 2015 at 7pm at the Exploration Gateway. This event is being sponsored by the Perry Sippo Friends of the Library and is free for the public to attend.

Scared Scriptless is Canton's professional improv comedy troupe. Their entire performance is unscripted and each show is different from the next. The group has been performing since 2006 at locations such as the Kathleen Howland Theatre, the Player's Guild of Canton, and First Friday Canton among other locations throughout Canton and Stark County. It is rare for the group to offer a show free of charge, but because of the support of Perry Sippo Friends of the Library this event is free to attend.
