Stark County District Library, The Smart Store, where everything is free® to host sewing program in collaboration with The Ohio State University Extension Services.

April 21, 2015 (Canton, OH) –The Stark County District Library, The Smart Store, where everything is free® will host “Ready to Sew” at the Main Library on Saturday, May 9, 2015 from 10-11:30am. The program is free and open to the public, but registration is required.

“Ready to Sew” is the third session in a series on sewing that has been offered to adults in collaboration with The Ohio State University Extension Services. Attendees of the upcoming program are not required to have attended either of the previous two programs, although they should note that in previous sessions the basics of stitching and cutting patterns were covered. This program will be taught by Louise Harding, Master Clothing Educator from The Ohio State University Extension Services.

In an effort to accommodate all patrons and draw in those who are new to sewing, Stark County District Library has made fabric and simple patterns available for event participants. Registered participants may pick up fabric and patterns at the Main Library several days prior to the program.
