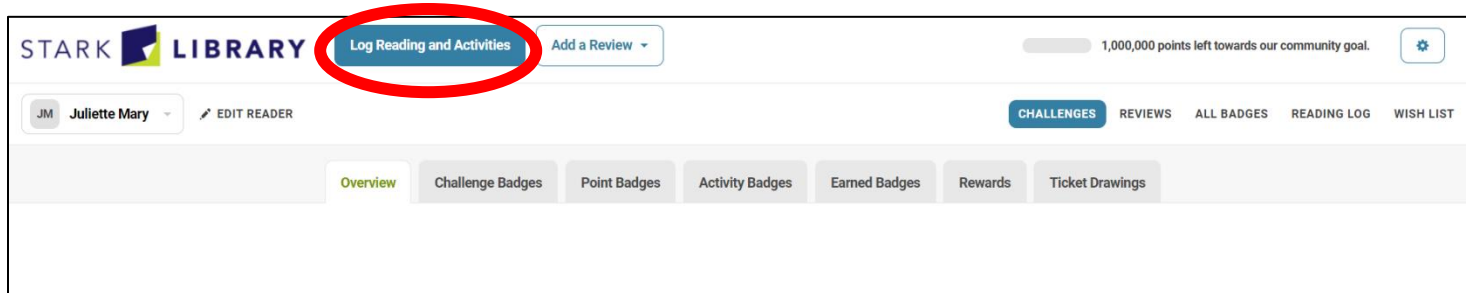


Logging Days Read for the Summer Challenge:

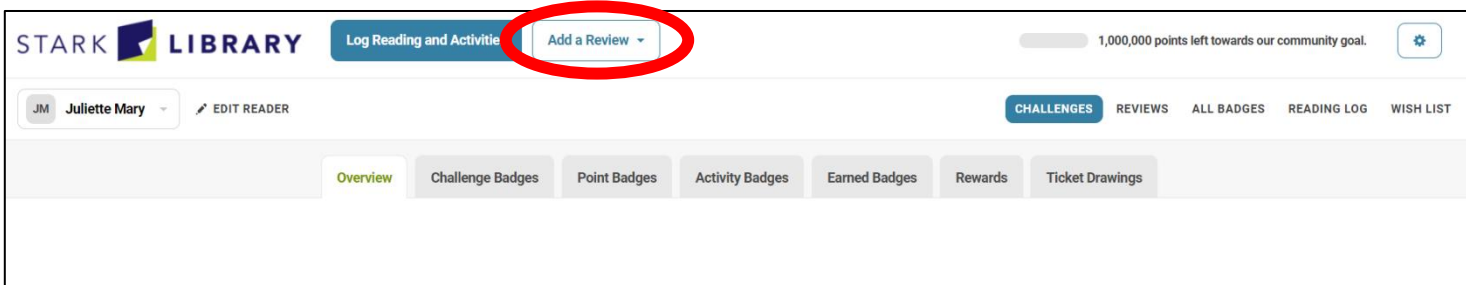
1. Visit <https://starklibrary.beanstack.org>.
2. Sign into your account.
3. To log a specific number of days read for the Summer Challenge, select LOG READING AND ACTIVITIES at the top of the page.



4. Select **Days** from the menu of options. For the Summer Challenge, we count days read, not books.
5. Select the number of days read via the calendar.
6. Once you click the LOG button, it will register your points. You should earn 20 points for each day read.

Logging Book Reviews for the Summer Challenge:

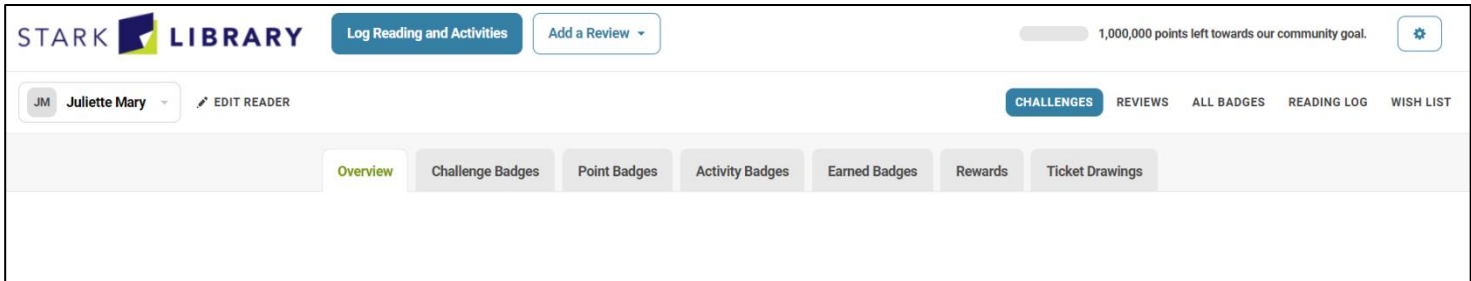
1. Visit <https://starklibrary.beanstack.org>.
2. Sign into your account.
3. To log a book review for the Summer Challenge, select ADD A REVIEW at the top of the page.
4. You can select Write a Review or Post a Picture Review.



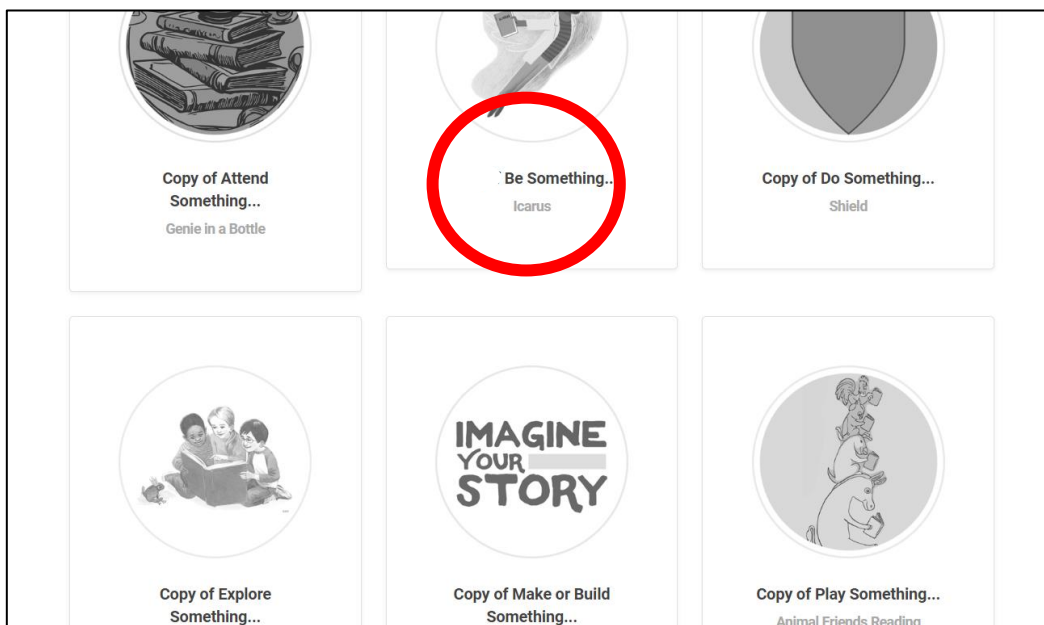
5. Once you click the SAVE button, it will register your points. You should earn 20 points for your review.

Logging Activities for the Summer Challenge:

1. Visit <https://starklibrary.beanstack.org>.
2. Sign into your account.
3. To log activities completed for the Summer Challenge, select the ACTIVITY BADGES tab.



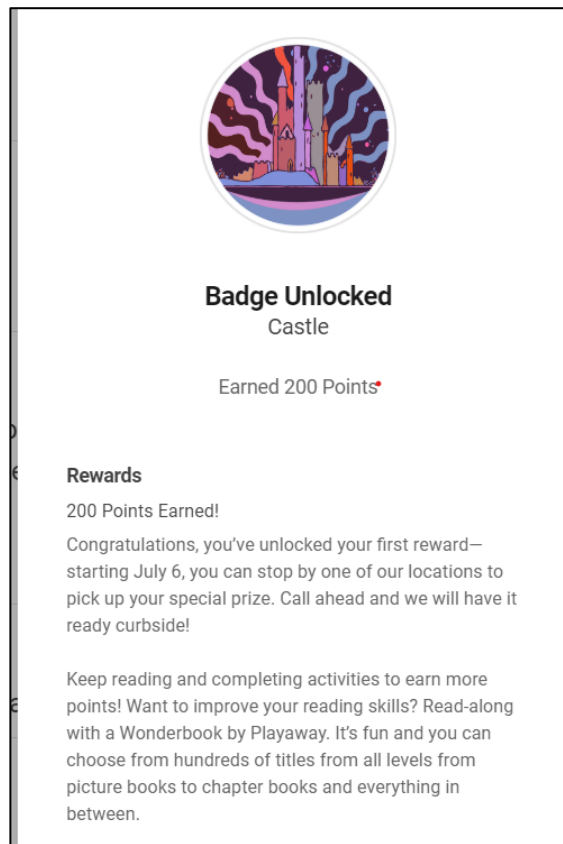
4. There are over 35 activities listed under six categories. They are listed online as they are on the paper maps. Each activity listed in the different categories is worth 20 points.
5. Select a category to find an activity to complete.



6. Activities vary in the type of fun required. Some ask for information before selecting that you have completed them. Some just need a checkmark. Once you select the checkbox, you will earn 20 points for that activity. Activities can only be completed one time.
7. Don't forget to look under each badge to find more activities!

Earning Badges for the Summer Challenge:

1. Once your child or teen achieves 200 points, it unlocks the first reward badge. You will receive a notification via email and/or a pop-up box on your screen.



2. Children in grades Kindergarten through 5th grade will have the option of dropping virtual tickets in the Grand Prize raffle of their choosing. They have seven options.
3. Children birth through preschool and Teens will have tickets automatically put into a drawing.
4. To complete the program, participants need to earn at least 500 points. For every 100 pointes earned beyond 500, they will earn an extra ticket into the grand prize drawing.
